



Silver Dollar City's 2015 Festival Highlights

New for 2015, Silver Dollar City presents Fireman's Landing, an \$8 million all-new themed area with 10 new family adventures. Opening in March, Fireman's Landing substantially increases the park's attractions, adding six family rides and four interactive play zones for kids and families, with theming that salutes the spirit and training activities of volunteer firefighters. Plus, new for *Star-Spangled Summer*, the park presents the world famous Harlem Globetrotters in their first-ever extended-run show, making 2015 the park's *biggest family year ever*.

WORLD-FEST (April 9 - May 3)

America's largest international festival celebrates the cultures and heritages that built our nation:

- NEW: Cirque Zuma Zuma, a show featuring a troupe of 28 African performers, including acrobats presenting acts of balance, juggling, pyramids and more, plus dancers and musicians. Plus, an African Village pre-show presents music acts with African drummers and musicians.
