

#### What is Cyber Security and why does it matter to you?

Most of us, if not all, are online daily whether we like it or not. The Internet has evolved into more than just machine talking to machine. We are doing business online, researching for information online, banking online, shopping online, study online, heck we're even socializing online. The Internet or Cyberspace has become a part of life. We are no longer invited to parties via cards through the mail; we are instead sent Facebook invites. Needless to say Cyberspace is here to stay and we (and our kids) are spending a tremendous amount of time in Cyberspace.

As we spend more time in Cyberspace, our risks of becoming Cybercrime victims are also increase.

#### How do Cybercriminals make money?

**Botnets:** Are a giant computer network all over the world that send out millions of spam messages. The Botnets (or zombie army) were created by cybercriminals taking over not well protected computers. The Botnets are rented out for the following activities:

Phishing scams: The infamous Nigerian scams with promises of huge amounts of cash in return for you paying what seems like a relatively small sum to release the funds. The FedEx scam. The banking and IRS scams. Spam: Many of the emails we received today are unwanted emails (or spam). They try soliciting their products without your consent. While many are harmless, some has potential viruses like the infamous XP Antivirus.

Viruses and Spyware: Some emails contain viruses and spywares to create more bots for the Botnets. Some contain viruses like fake antivirus. Some contain spywares or keyloggers that steal passwords, credit card numbers, bank credential, and other sensitive personal information.

Fake Antivirus: The fake antivirus that claims to get rid of thousands of malware infected your computer. It grants your computer useless until you pay a ransom.

#### What can I do?

Have a firewall: Firewall protects your perimeters like a door at your home.

Have Antivirus & Antispyware: If you don't have one GET one. If you can afford it get commercial antivirus software like Trend Micro, Kaspersky, Symantec, Vipre, etc., then use a free one like Avast of AVG. AND keep it up-to-date. It can only help if it has the latest update of virus definition. Mac users; Don't EVER think that Macs are immune. False sense of security is worse than NOT having security.

Use your common sense when opening emails: If something too good to be true. IT IS. Don't click on any links that look suspicious, even if it comes from someone you know.

Updates and patches: Keep your computers up-to-date with security updates and patches.

Protect your children: If you have children at home, additional protection and cautions are advisable.

- Keep computers in public area that can be monitored and within your eyesight.
- Software like Net Nanny, McAfee Safe Eyes, etc. can be used to filter contents, set online time, monitor chat, monitor emails, etc.
- Monitor your child's Facebook and emails and watch for sex predators, bullies, and inappropriate activities.

**Backup your data**: Accidental deletion, hard drive failure, and virus infection will happen, so backup your data. There are many backup solutions available. BDR from BDS offers 15 minutes increment backup and is completely automated.

**Offsite Storage:** Remember Joplin? Enough said! Have a disaster plan or at least store your data offsite. Your data can take months to recreate. BDR from BDS send a copy nightly to our data center for offsite storage.




